- Arrive on Friday, November 4, 2011 between 3:00 pm and 6:00 pm. Dinner served at 7:00 pm at the Inn (Menu will be sent out 2 weeks prior). Start getting to know some of the other suspects (I mean guests). An explanation of the weekends activities will begin as the table is cleared. We are currently working on getting a forensic investigator to educate us on crime scene investigation techniques. Be on your guard for clues and search the common areas of the inn for more information.
- Saturday morning brings one of Janet's marvelous breakfasts along with a discussion of case updates that may have occurred during the night. Be sure to talk with the other guests and be on the watch for those seeming to be having private conversations—they may be talking about you or have information that you need to know. You better start figuring out which of your fellow guests is the murderer. Also, keep an eye out as they may kill someone around you to keep them quiet (did you have a clue that might put you in danger?).

Now go out and enjoy a hike or maybe wander over to the Giles County Historical Society and learn about the great area around you (who knows, they may even have some information you may find helpful in the case).

Meet back at the Inn mid-day as you may find the person you though was the murderer—has been murdered. More clues will be supplied.

On to dinner at The Palisades Restaurant or possibly The Bank Food and Drink (tba). Stay on guard and keep listening. What was that the waiter just muttered?
